Candidate profile

Primary function:

The pastor provides leadership to the members of Munich Christian Fellowship (MCF) enabling them to focus on the Great Commission, and equipping them to carry out [MCF's Mission Statement](#)

Responsibilities:

- **Leading:** The pastor, who believes in MCF's Statement of Faith, will lead and equip the congregation to fulfil the Great Commission and accomplish the vision statement of MCF.
- **Preaching:** The pastor will preach and teach the Bible, believing that it has God for its author, salvation for its end, and truth without any mixture of error for its matter.
- **Ministering:** The pastor will use his spiritual gifts to edify and build this local body of believers. The pastor will provide appropriate pastoral care like counselling to members of MCF and the community, and will equip the members of the leadership team to do the same.



Expectations:

- The pastor is expected to live an exemplary life modelling the call, character, and competencies becoming a minister of the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- The pastor will demonstrate a servant spirit as a growing disciple of Jesus Christ.
- Overseas experience in an international church is considered an asset.
- The pastor is expected to be approachable, friendly, and flexible (open to change).

Compensation:

- Church support to the pastor of 36.000 euro per annum. The pastor is expected and allowed to raise his own financial support or have a part-time job to supplement the pastor salary.

- **Three references** (non-family members' names and contact information)
- **Cover letter** with your Testimony and answer to the following questions:
 1. What drives you as pastor? What are you passionate about, as expressed by the major ministry emphases in your life and/or pastorate(s)? What are these?
 2. What role does your family play in your ministry?
 3. Describe some of the joys and challenges you have experienced in living abroad and ministering to a multicultural international congregation (if applicable)?
 4. Why do you feel called to pastor an international church? And why MCF, in particular?
 5. How do you feel about the MCF statement of faith? And the MCF Mission and Values?
